

## Amanda Wick, MMT, MT-BC:

Amanda Wick is a Board–Certified Music Therapist serving in the St. Louis metro area for the past six years. She graduated with a bachelor's in music therapy in 2017 from Illinois State University and a master's in music therapy in 2023 from Maryville University, where she received the Leadership in Music Therapy award.

In 2017 Amanda Wick completed her music therapy internship at Big Bend Hospice in Tallahassee, FL. After this, she moved back to her hometown of Highland, IL, and began working for Music Therapy St. Louis, serving various clients on both sides of the river. In 2021, Amanda branched off on her own, providing individual and group music therapy to a variety of contracts in Illinois, while also pursuing her master's degree at Maryville University. As part of her graduate degree, Amanda served as a graduate assistant at Maryville University, working with undergraduate students in learning about music therapy, including teaching about music therapy techniques, ethical skills, and clinical writing.

Amanda Wick currently serves as the clinical coordinator at Maryville University, where she provides clinical supervision for music therapy undergraduate and graduate students and clinical placement opportunities within the St. Louis community. Recently, Amanda Wick led Creative Music Making (2024), a community music therapy event in St. Louis.
