What is Batten Disease?

Batten disease, or Neuronal Ceroid Lipofuscinosis (NCL), is a family of rare diseases caused by genetic mutations, which disrupts cells' ability to dispose of waste in the brain. It is estimated that 2-4 babies per 100,000 are born in the U.S. with Batten disease.



Children and adults with Batten disease suffer progressive neurological impairment because of their damaged cells, including visual and ambulatory impairment, as well as seizures, and premature death.
